

Affects of Climate Change

This will be a pencil and paper event where students are asked a series of questions relating to Affects of Climate Change.

Students may be asked:

- about severe storms and droughts
- US policies
- Greenhouse emissions
- Health and environmental effects
- about biogeochemical cycles and their relation to climate changes

Bring only a pencil. You may *not* use references during the meet.

- This event requires teams to have a minimum of two people. You may have up to the league maximum of four members.
- Each team will be expected to hand in one answer sheet at the end of the 30 minute session.
- The event format will consist of fill-in-the-blank questions.
- All scores will be normalized to the 50 point scale.
- Earliest answer sheet will be used to break tie scores.
