CSI: NORTH SHORE SCIENCE LEAGUE

A CRIME HAS BEEN COMMITTED AND THE LOCAL POLICE ARE SHORT A FEW GOOD SCIENTISTS. THEY HAVE CALLED THE NORTH SHORE SCIENCE LEAGUE TO STEP IN AND HELP SOLVE THE CASE.

THE EVENT WILL BE SET UP IN STATIONS. EACH TEAM WILL VISIT 6 DIFFERENT STATIONS FOR 5 MINUTES APIECE (THERE WILL BE DUPLICATE STATIONS AVAILABLE AND THE ORDER OF STATIONS VISITED IS IRRELEVANT, SO EACH TEAM CAN MOVE TO ALL 6 STATIONS WITHIN ABOUT 30 MINUTES). THEY WILL ARRIVE AT A STATION, LOOK OVER THE EVIDENCE AND INFORMATION AVAILABLE AND ANSWER A SERIES OF QUESTIONS ON A HANDOUT GIVEN TO THEM AT THE BEGINNING OF THE EVENT.

BY THE END OF THE EVENT TEAMS WILL HAVE ANSWERED SEVERAL QUESTIONS HELPING THEM DETERMINE WHAT TOOK PLACE AT THE CRIME SCENE, FIGURE OUT A POSSIBLE CAUSE OF DEATH, AND POSSIBLY IDENTIFY THE CULPRIT. QUESTIONS ABOUT GENERAL FORENSICS AND ARE FOUND AT STATION #6.

THE TEAMS WILL BE SCORED BASED ON THE NUMBER OF THE QUESTIONS THEY ANSWER CORRECTLY. ALL SCORES WILL BE NORMALIZED TO THE 50 POINT SCALE.
