



WILDFLOWERS OF NEW ENGLAND

OBJECTIVE: To correctly identify 25 common wildflowers of New England from photographs, pictures and/or actual specimens.

PROCEDURE:

- There will be 25 stations with one wildflower at each.
- You need to be able to identify the flowers by their common names.
- You also need to know some ecological and/or historical information concerning each wildflower.
- Each team will have 1½ minutes at each station for reading and identification.
- You may bring in one source to use during the event (not electronic!!)

SCORING: Each answer (flower and one other fact) is worth 2 points for a total maximum of 50 pts.

EVENT PREPARATION: Use reference books (including scientific encyclopedias) to prepare for the event.
