

CSI 11/8/11: SOLVED:

The murder victim was most likely murdered by Lisa, his jealous ex-girlfriend.

Lisa was not the closest to the crime scene, but not far away either. She had no one to confirm her alibi, had abnormal blood results matching the substance found at the scene, is taller than the victim (the blow to the head came from above), and, although she did not have direct access to the murder weapon, her best friend Sarah did!

As for the other suspects:

Jennifer had 5 people to witness her alibi and no access to the murder weapon. Nor did she leave any evidence at the crime scene.

Joanna had no connection to the murder weapon and had coworkers to bear witness to her alibi. Nor did she leave any evidence at the crime scene.

Edward had a motive (frustrated with his time in detention) and no reliable alibi, but no reasonable access to or connection with the murder weapon. Nor did he leave any evidence at the crime scene.

Richard was the one that caused the bruising around the neck and randomly ran over his foot after time of death, but had no reasonable access to or connection with the murder weapon.

Sarah had a strong connection to the murder weapon, but her alibi was well witnessed and she had no motive to kill the victim.

Emily had access to the murder weapon and a shaky alibi, but she left absolutely no evidence at the crime scene.
